Registration

Please note, exhibitor badges will state the exhibiting company name and 'EXHIBITOR' only and will not contain personal first names or surnames. Exhibition staff will need to receive their badges before being allowed access onto the exhibition floor. You are not required to register online for your set entitlement of exhibitor registrations; these are automatically allocated to you.
